1. Approval of April Board Meeting Minutes. Passed Unanimously

2. Report from Nominating Committee, Marnelle Gleason.

- Interested in continuity as well as youth on the new board.
- · Most positions need to be filled next year.
- Some positions need special skill and knowledge, like Treasurer.
- The new bylaws will add a comforting amount of flexibility and authority for the new board to modify meetings.

3. Membership discussion about the by-laws, Deb.

- The board will send another message to membership to remind them of the coming vote at the May membership meeting.
- We will limit discussion at the meeting to 15 minutes.

4. Report on 600k Brevet, Deb.

• 51 riders signed up. Four DNF. Two who did not show. 49 riders started. 45 riders finished.

- There was a significant crash that began with wheel-crossing and involved several riders.
 No major injuries.
- Morning start this year. Generally great reviews by the riders.
- Discussion about how much the club subsidizes the brevets. Goal is to have the rides be revenue neutral. This is the most expensive of our brevets due to distance.
- Next brevet is August 19.

5. DC report, Bill B.

- 376 riders in total are signed up for all three rides. Five chose the five mile route. 35 chose the 100 mile route. The majority or riders chose 200 miles. Compared to last year, we have 50 fewer registrations.
- The 45 and 100 mile rides are the most profitable distances as there are low incremental costs compared to the registration fee.
- Many volunteers show up at the last minute, so we expect all positions to be filled.
- A participant has asked about using an e-bike, and another asked about using a fairing.
- · Hector expressed interest in learning to run the DC next year.

6. Race Team report, Atac.

- A Race Team member died from a head-on collision with a motorcycle during a recent training ride in Redding. The motorcyclist sustained major injuries. We have no details of the incident. It is still being investigated.
- The three riders who were hit by a truck recently are all recovering from their injuries.
- Last Tuesday a north-bound driver on Mace Blvd struck a Race Team member who was crossing at Second St. during his commute to Sacramento. The cyclist sustained major injuries and is in ICU.
- The Race Team supports UCD cycling team with \$1000 from the RT budget. One rider is now sixth position in the nationals. Another is first place in Golden State Races.
- 4th of July Criterion is coming up soon.

7. Philanthropy report, Dick.

- We received over \$1000 from March Madness.
- Discussion about cleaning up a section of road we ride on regularly. Plan is to garner positive exposure for the DBC.
