 association online); Cynthia Black, EMT donates money to the fire
 association
 - ii. Other Requests made for:
 - 1. Zombie Ride \$1000; Bike Campaign/ Bike Garage \$1000 + \$2000
 - Motion was made to sponsor Zombie Ride in the amount of \$250, motion was seconded and passed unanimously, motion carried
 - iii. Budgeted \$2500 for the year, \$1500 goes to the USBHOF; theoretically have \$1000 until the end of February 2023; finances still recovering from Pandemic
 - Suggested revisiting donating to Bike Campaign/Bike Garage after Foxy's and possibly increasing philanthropy budget
