Hi Trish and Kurt,

Trish and I talked briefly about supporting an event where we encourage kids to bike to the movies on a Wednesday afternoon in May (May is bike month). Idea is to have them bike from their elementary school to downtown — watch a movie and then bike back. This is going to require some chaperones for each site.

I spoke with Sinisa (owner of Varsity Theather) and he is willing to try this. It sounds like his cost is \$250 to be able to show the movie – theather seats 270. Regular ticket is 8 or so, so if we make the combined ticket \$5 – or even less per ticket – purchased as part of a bike and movie package – the kids get an inexpensive movie experience while biking there and back.

I will talk with Sinisa some more — but I hope that with some financial support from Bike Davis and the Davis Bike Club — we can subsidize this to make it free or cheap for the kids who sign up. Planting a seed for now — will try to iron out details and come back for a more formal ask. Let me know what you think. This could be a one—time thing — or we could make it a monthly recurring event.
